

New Referral Process – Piloting Spring 2022

-Now What workshops offered bi-weekly

Rather than referring a student who has just decided they are interested in healthcare to a one-on-one advising meeting, encourage them to attend a workshop first.

Transfer students, less common careers (midwifery, chiropractic, etc.) and students that are outside the norm (freshman with extensive credit, nontraditional students) may need to be referred directly to pre-health advisor rather than a workshop
